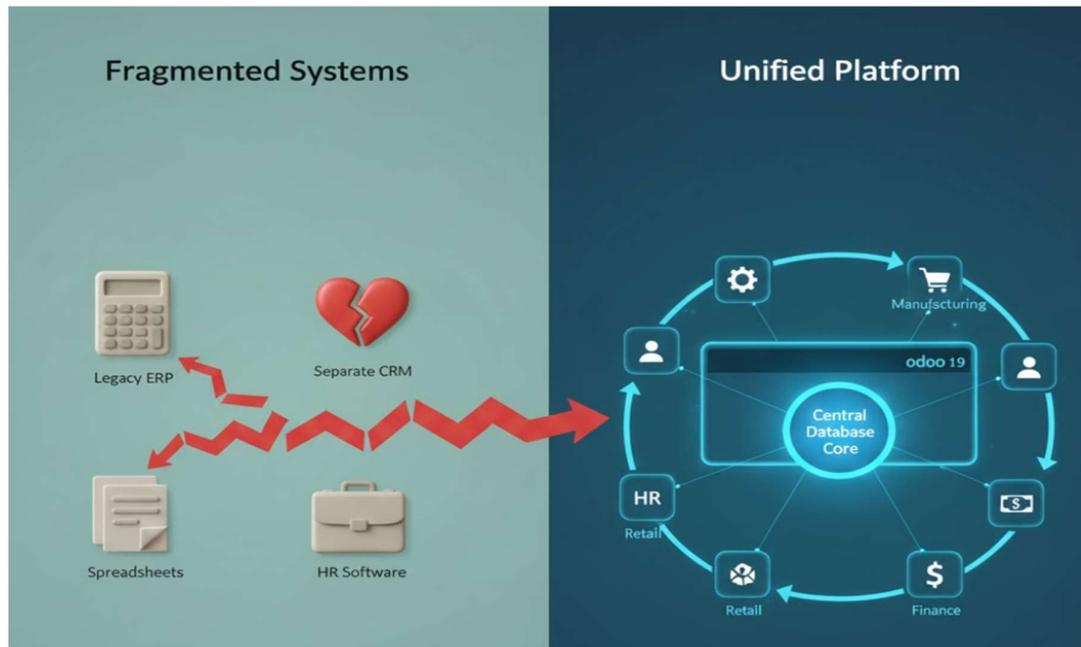


Odoo 19: The Game-Changer for Pet Wise Operations
